Removal of the eye

Equipment required

- 1. A hard hat, particularly if working in an abattoir or knackery
- 2. Safety eye glasses
- 3. Strong gloves
- 4. Overalls
- 5. Rubber boots (gumboots)
- 6. One sharp knife
- 7. One plastic 2 litre jar with a screw top lid half filled with 10% buffered formalin for the eye
- 8. Knee pads to make working in the kneeling position cleaner and more comfortable (optional)
- 9. A piece of carpet to serve as a good working surface for this procedure (optional).

Step-by-step instructions to remove the eye

- 1. Using a knife, cut away the top eyelid.
- 2. Using a knife, cut around the eye.
- 3. Loosen the eye so it can be prolapsed (fall out of place).
- 4. Sever the attachments as the eye is rolled out.
- 5. Place the eye into the jar of 10% buffered formalin to fix. **Do not freeze**.
- 6. Submit the eye and any other specimens to the accredited laboratory in your state or territory.
